#### Eco Council - visit



On Monday the 26<sup>th</sup> June we had a visit from Jill Armshaw and Dr William Jones from Hughenden Parish Council. We invited them to meet with our Eco Council so the children could find how the Parish Council operates and to explore what projects the Parish Council undertake to help our local environment. Hughenden Eco Council got to ask questions about the role the councillors have and how decisions are made within the Parish Council. The Eco Council shared their vision about Eco projects around

our school including the planting of new hedging, raised beds, recycling crisps packets in the lunch hall, recycling used pens and how we might reduce the amount of paper we use in school. The Parish Councillors then had a tour of the school and they we very impressed with our green spaces. We agreed that we should stay in contact to see if we can help them or they can help us with local projects.



#### Summer Swimming Intensive Courses 2022

We are running 5 weeks of Intensive Swimming Lesson Courses plus Stroke Clinics to keep kids active this summer!

Intensive courses are 30 minutes a day running Monday to Friday, focusing on developing the strokes and skills of the stages. These are £37.50 for the 5 sessions.

Stroke Clinic classes are one-off 30-minute sessions for swimmers Stage 5 and above, focusing on refining the specific stroke. These are £7.50 each session.
