It's a Boy! – Jack William Messenger


We're pleased to announce the safe arrival of Jack William Messenger who was born on Saturday 17th. Mum and baby are both home safely and settling into their new routines.

7th March World Book Day

As shared on Class Dojo, World Book Day is taking place on Thursday 7th March. As like previous years, we actively encourage everyone (adults as well)

23th March-7th - April Exciting National Trust Competition

Bikeability Level 2 cycling training.

We will be holding Bikeability Level 2 cycling training (subject to our funding application being approved) for children in Years 5 and 6. The training will take place from Monday 15 July to Wednesday 17 July 2024 and there will be 24 spaces available. Letters will come out in the Summer Term.

The Bikeability Level 2 course aims to improve rider's skills and confidence for cycling on smaller roads and simple junctions without too much traffic. It prepares riders for cycling on larger and busier roads and more complicated junctions. The course covers all of the Bikeability Level 1 fundamentals which ensures children are safe to ride on the roads. Each child will require a roadworthy bike and a helmet.
